












## Pinwheel Path















































































































































































## METER'S COUPLING RANGE

The coupling range is a scope in which light can be measured by a meter and differs according to the speed of the film used in a camera. If your camera incorporates a system in which light is measured at the full opening of the taking lens, the coupling range is also different according to the f-number of the lens at its full opening.



The range of the coupling of the meter to film speeds is surrounded by a bold line in the table. The meter is not coupled to the film speeds outside this line.

If the meter goes out of the coupling range, the shutter speed dial stops and cannot be turned further. In the event you desire to set the camera to a shutter speed outside the coupling range and take pictures not under the electric eye system, depress the "OVERRIDE" lever 18 in the arrow-marked direction and turn the shutter dial to set the shutter speed.

In the event that the film speed and shutter speed are changed outside the coupling range of the meter, there are cases in which the meter needle is moved to indicate an f-stop and it looks as though the meter is coupled to both speeds.
