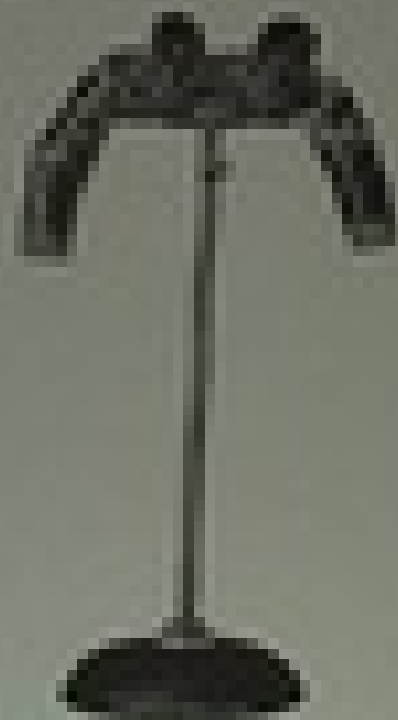


Diagram showing the effect of gravity on the motion of a body in a vertical direction.

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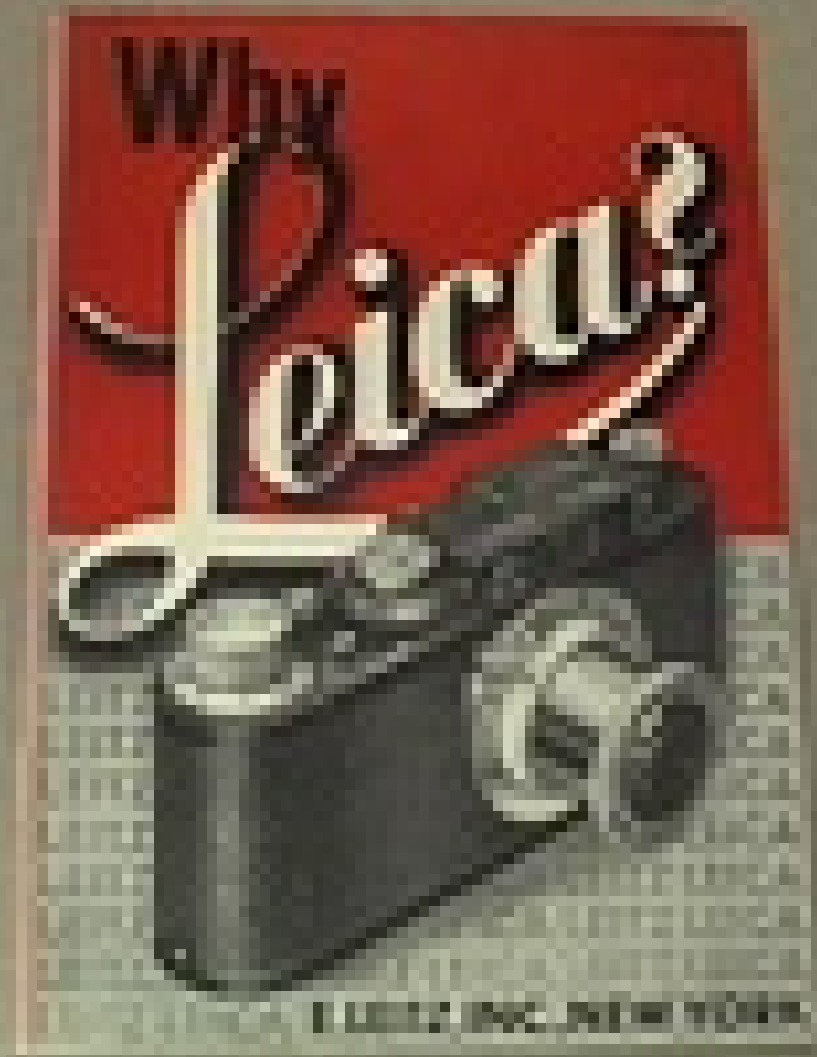

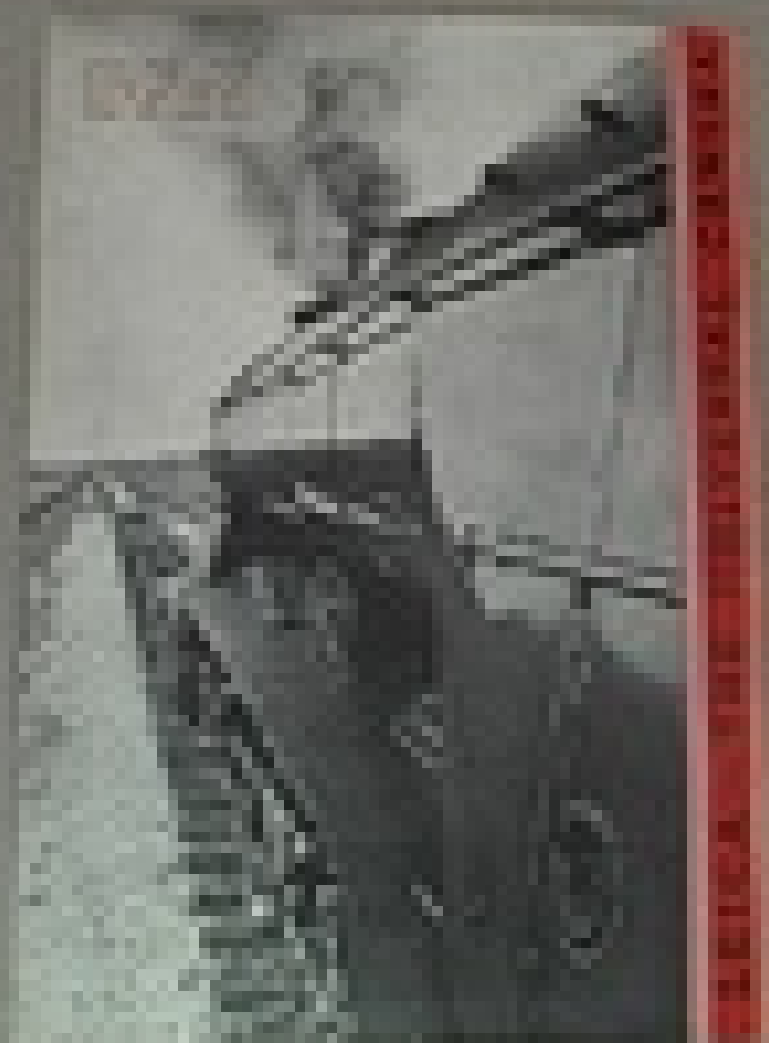
