FILTERS

The Angénieux filters are precision optical instruments. They contribute to the achievement of quality photographs. They must be treated with the same care as the lenses.

Technical characteristics

Close inspection is applied to the following points:
evenness and parallelism of the surfaces
treatment of the glass surfaces
precision of the mounting

Angénieux filters are presently available in diameters of :
36-42 mm adaptable to the 35-70 1/2 3.3 Angénieux zoom, without concession to vignetting
52 mm adaptable to the 70-210 1/3 5.2 zoom
62 mm adaptable to the DEM 180 1/2.3 APO and to the DEM 200 1/2.8 ED

Types of available filters

1 : against UV-A rays, particularly in the mountains or when shooting infrared photographs. By virtue of their protection, they can be kept on the lens without interruption.

2 : Circular Polarizing : against the reflections produced by all shiny surfaces. They increase the contrast of the landscape. They constrain to prolong the time of exposure by two. They are adaptable to autofocus cameras.



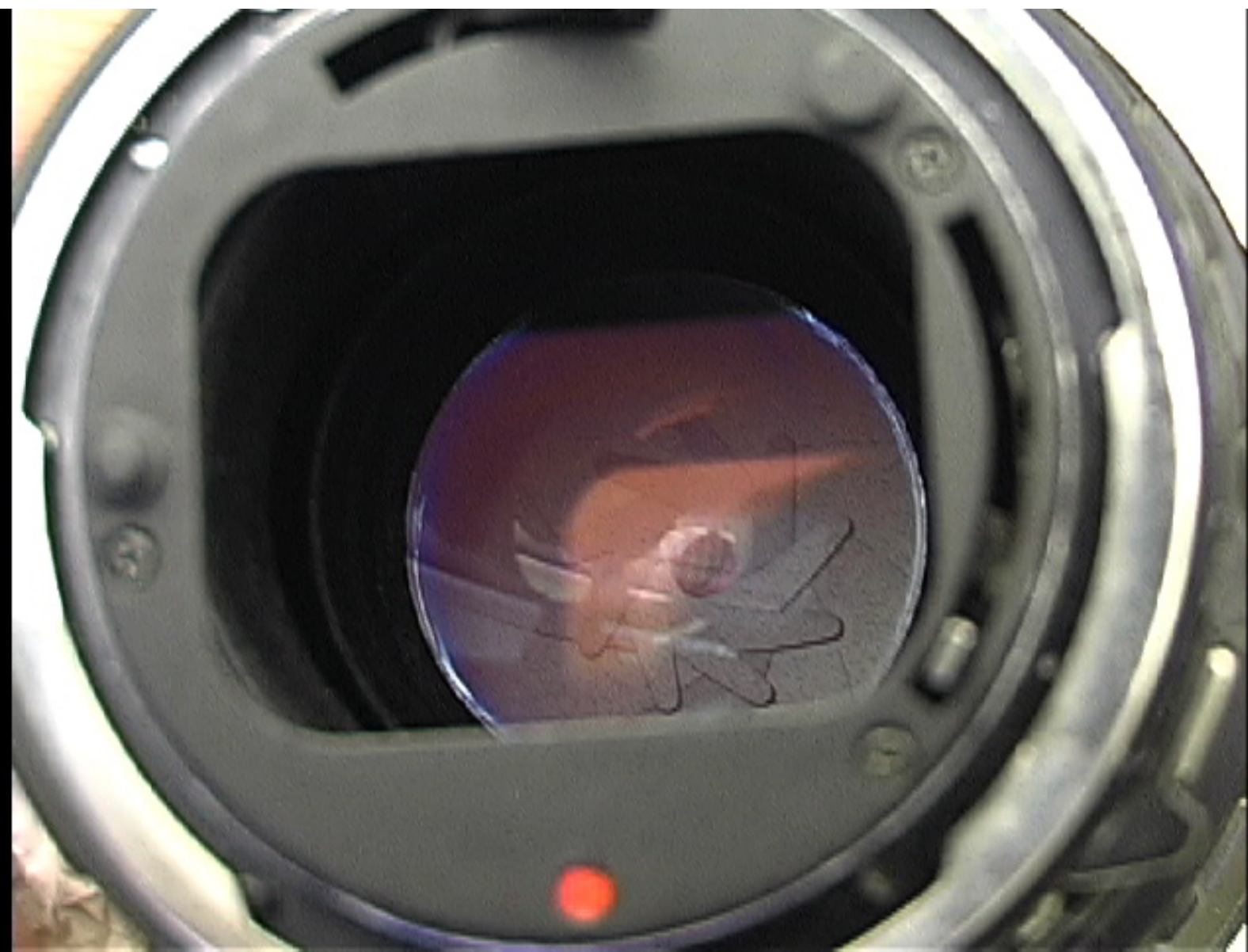
