





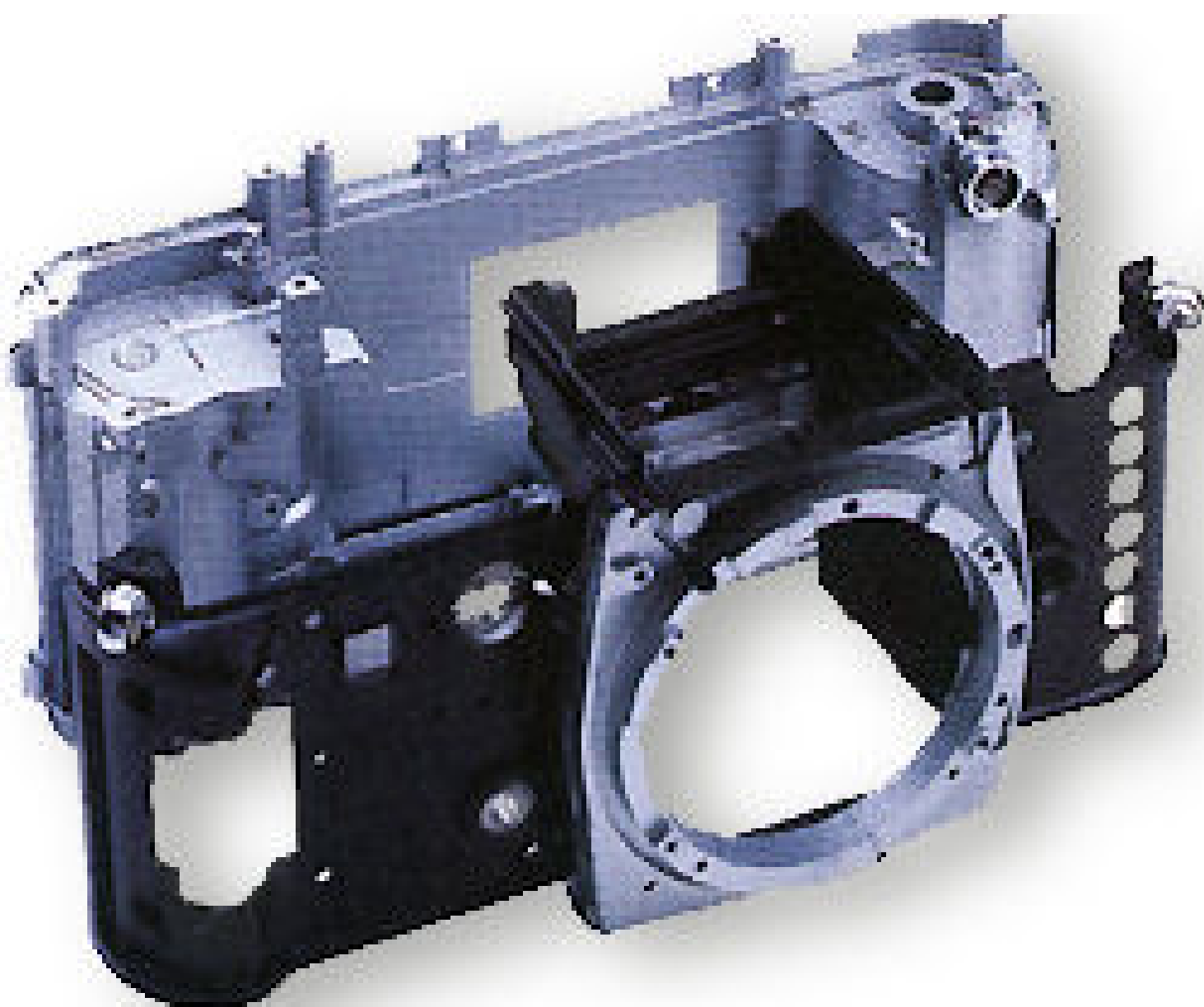












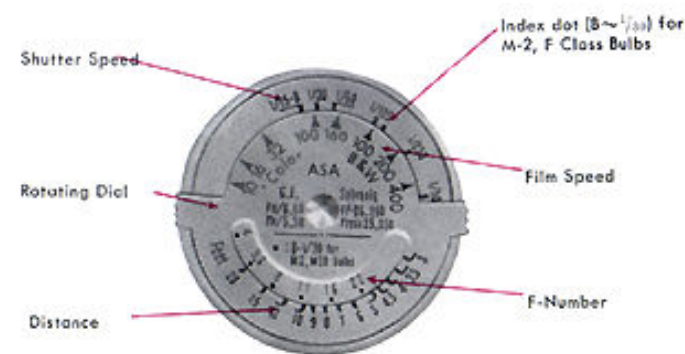

Example 1: Using FP class bulbs with black-and-white film

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Flash bulb used : G.E. No. 6, Sylvania FP-26, Mazda No. 6 or West No. 6
 Shutter speed : 1/125
 Film speed rating : ASA 100
 Distance to object : 10 ft. or 3m.

Set the ASA index 100 in black on the shutter speed 1/125.
 The f-stop to use at 10 ft. or 3m. is F : 11

16 Example 2 : Using M class bulbs with black-and-white film



Flash bulb used : G. E. No. 5, Sylvania Press 25, Mazda No. 5 or West M5 (TOSHIBA)
 Shutter speed : 1/60
 Film speed rating : ASA 100
 Distance to object : 12 ft. or 3.5m



Set the ASA index 100 in black on the shutter speed 1/60.
 The f-stop to use at 12 ft. or 3.5m is F : 16.

Example 3 : Using M2 bulbs with black-and-white film 17



Flash bulb used : G. E. M2, Sylvania M-2 or Mazda 2-M (TOSHIBA)
 Shutter speed : 1/30
 Film speed rating : ASA 100
 Distance to object : 10 ft. or 3m.



Set the ASA index 100 in black on the index dot (for B-1/30) located near 1/125.
 The f-stop to use at 10 ft. or 3m, is F : 11

18 Example 4: Using FP class bulbs with color film

Flash bulb used: G.E. No. 6B, Sylvania FP-26B, Mazda No. 6B or West No. 6B (TOSHIBA)
 Shutter speed: 1/125 second
 Film speed rating: ASA 32
 Distance to object: 9 ft. or 2.5m

Set the ASA index 32 in red on the shutter speed 1/125
 The f-stop to use at 9 ft. or 2.5m is F: 4

Example 5: Using M class bulbs with color film

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Flash bulb used: G.E. No. 5B, Sylvania 25B, Mazda No. 5B or West M5B (TOSHIBA)
 Shutter speed: 1/60 second
 Film speed rating: ASA 32
 Distance to object: 7 ft. or 2m.

Set the ASA index 32 in red on the shutter speed 1/60.
 The f-stop to use at 7 ft. or 2m. is F: 8

Example 6 : Using M2 bulb with color film

Flash bulb used : G. E. M2B, Sylvania M-2B, Mazda 2-MB (TOSHIBA)
 Shutter speed : 1/30 second
 Film speed rating : ASA 32
 Distance to object : 6 ft. or 1.7m.

Set the ASA index 32 in red on the index dot (for B-1/30) located near 1/125.

The f-stop to use at 6 ft. or 1.7m. is F : 5.6



TILTING REFLECTOR FOR BOUNCE FLASH

The reflector of the BC-5 Flash Unit can be tilted upwards and backwards through an angle of 135 degrees for bounce flash and held at any angle by the clockwise turning of the locking knob on the side.

The flash light reflected from the wall or ceiling gives a much softer lighting than the direct frontal light. However, as the intensity of the reflected light is much reduced, it is necessary to increase exposure over the direct method by the factor as shown in the following examples :

Position of reflector	①	②	③
f/number	normal	2 stop markings up	3 stop markings up
For example	f : 11	f : 5.6	f : 4

Note : The above figures are not always critical ; the proper exposure depends upon reflective nature of the surroundings and distance of the wall or ceiling. Color effect in color photography is also influenced by the color of the surroundings to some extent.



22 SYNCH. SELECTOR SETTING ON NIKON F, S3, S4 OR SP FOR VARIOUS TYPES OF FLASH BULBS

Small FP, M or F class bulbs are recommended for use with the Nikon. When the small FP or M bulb is used, select the color dot that matches the colored numbers on the shutter speed dial. For example, a shutter speed shown in green will match with the green dot.

When using F class bulbs, the color of the "F" figure must coincide with the color of the shutter speed being used.

For setting the correct lens aperture, determine the "Guide Number" by use of the exposure calculator on the flash unit.
