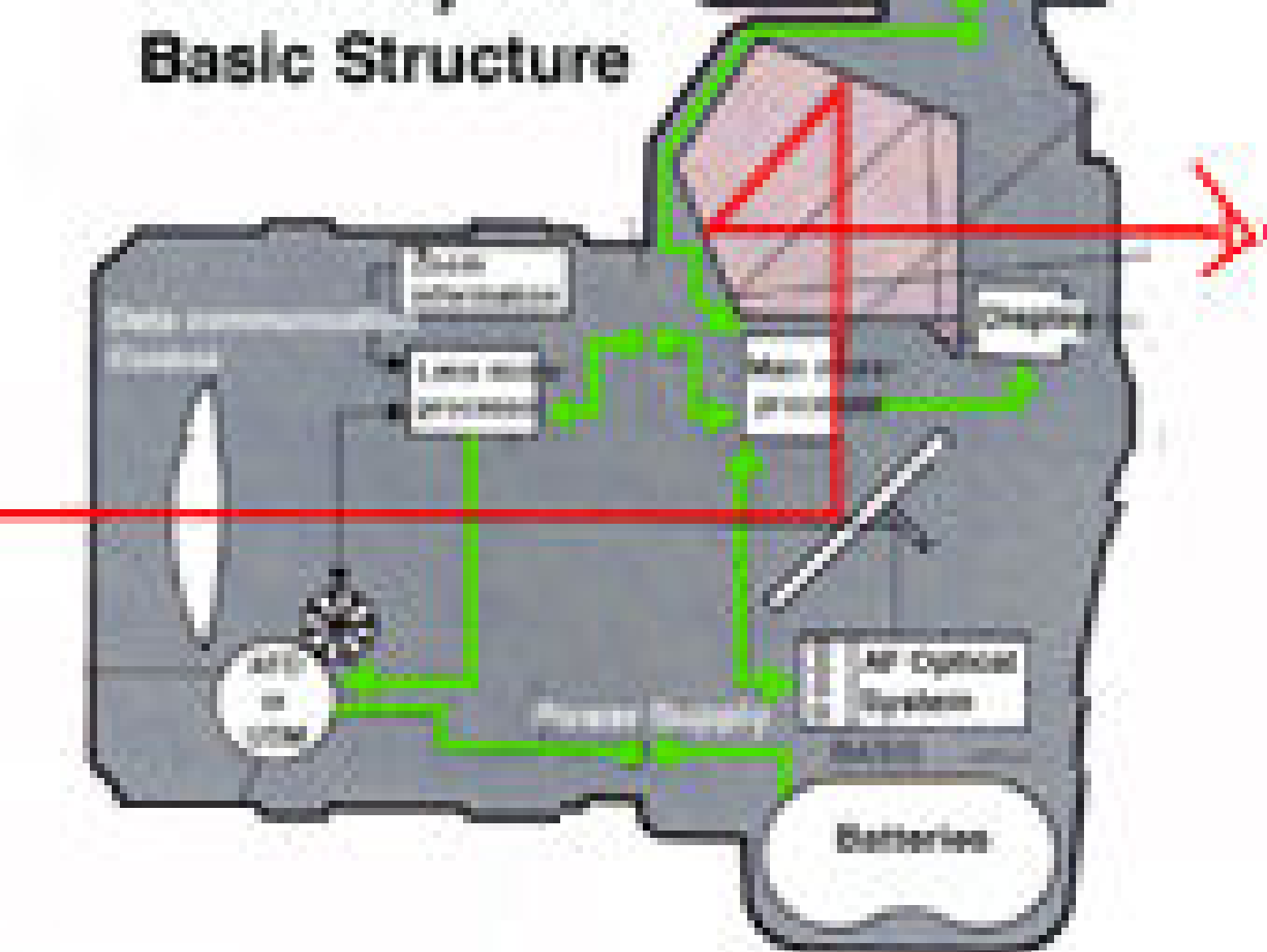

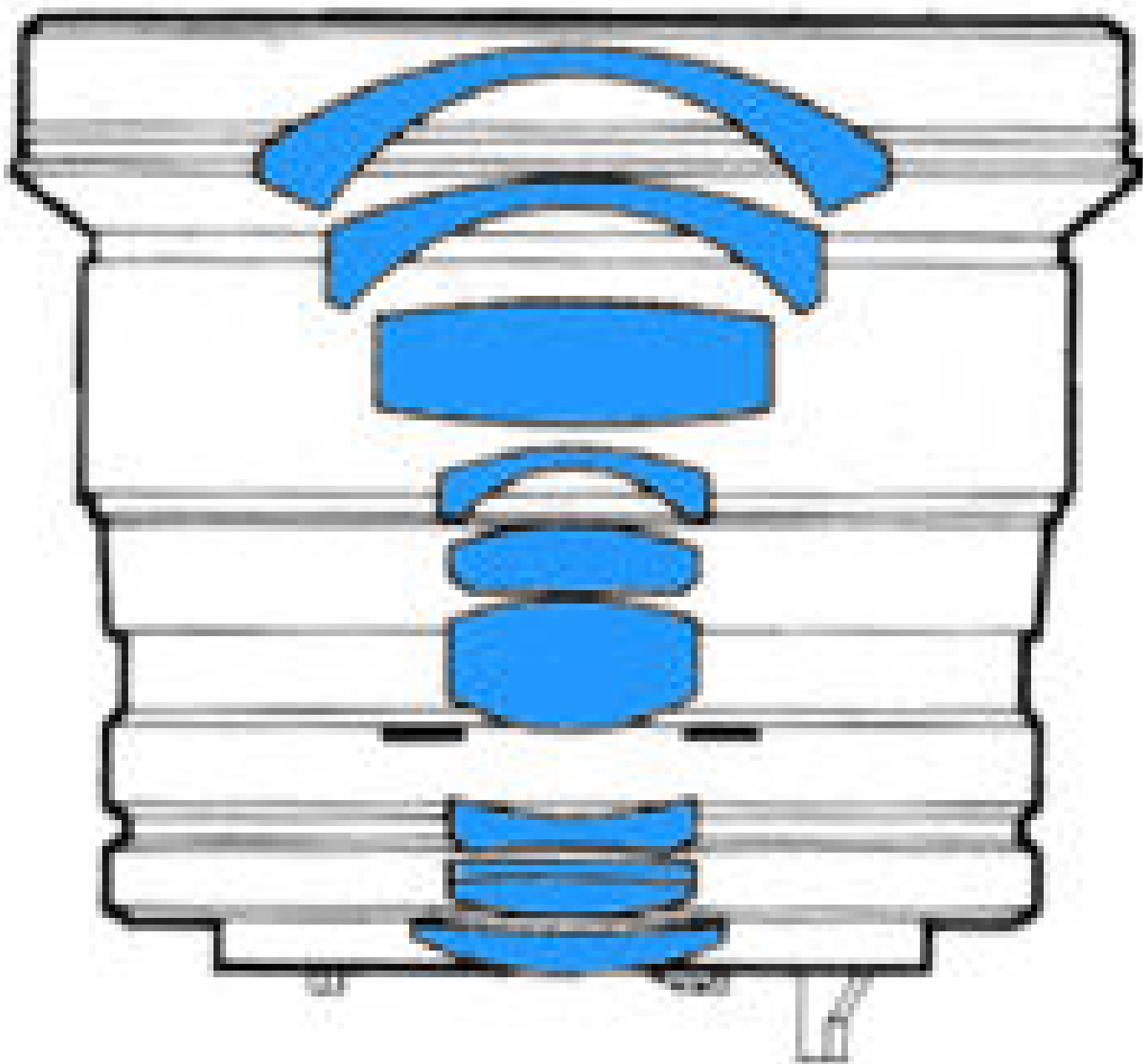








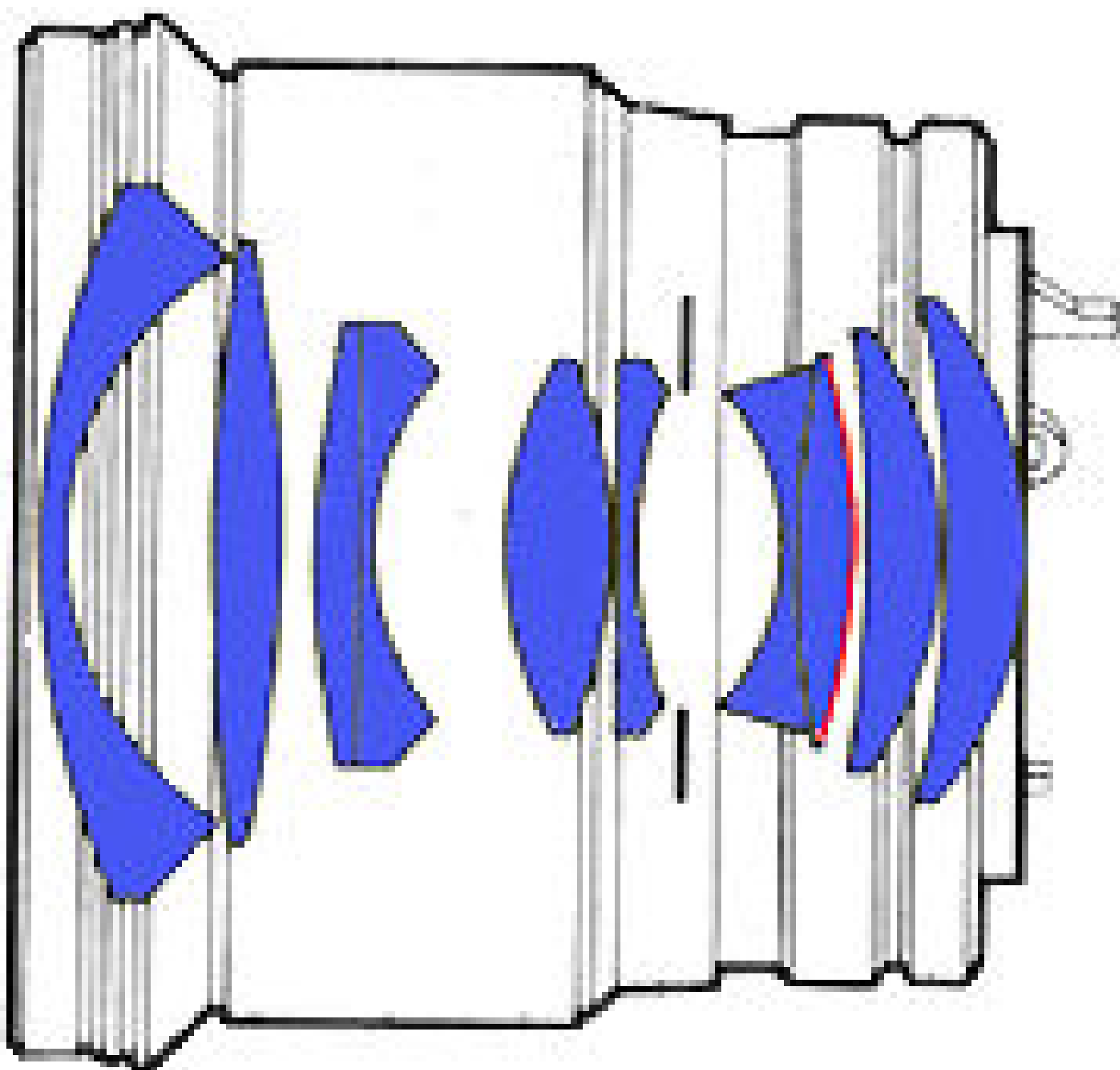








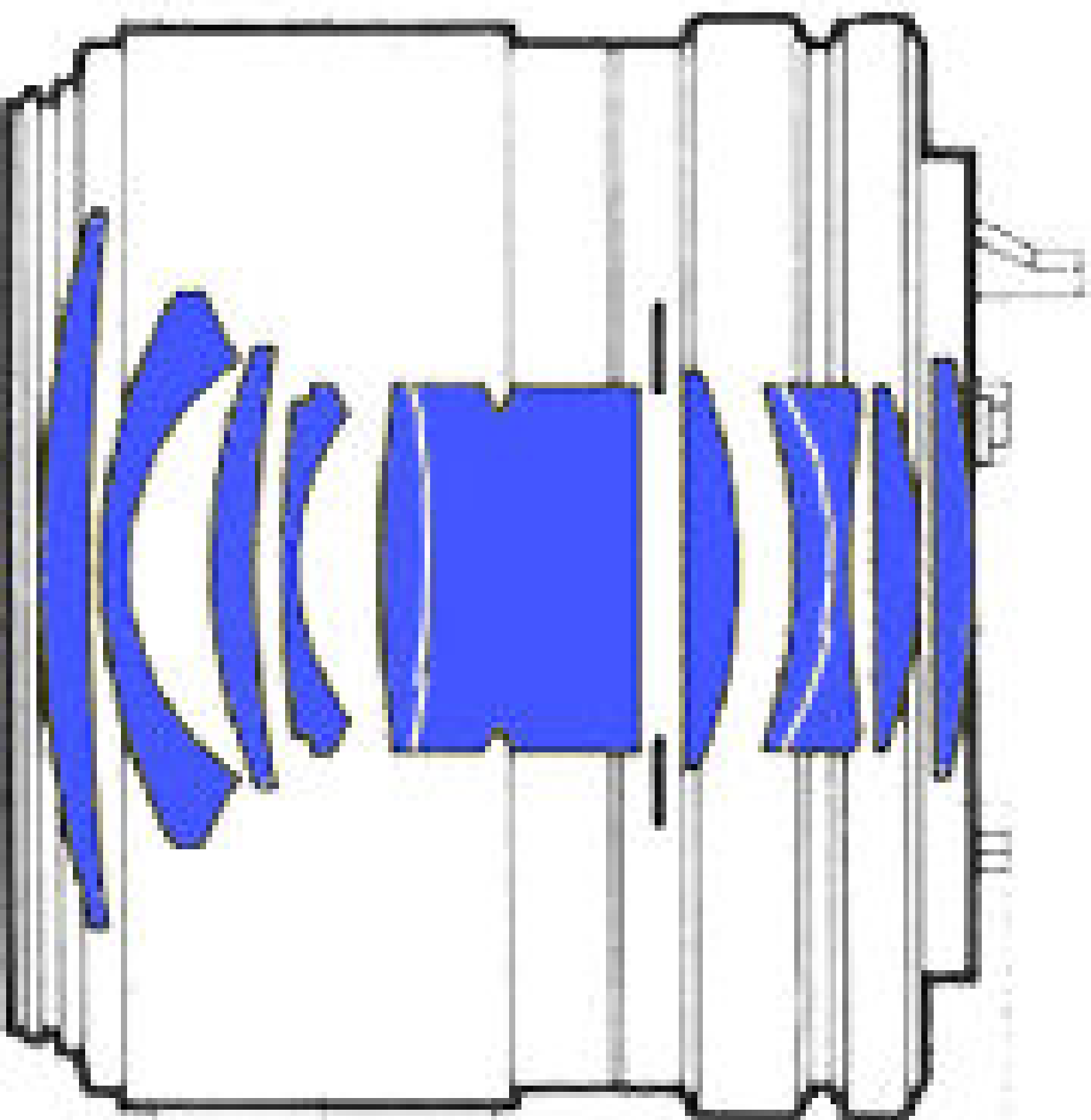




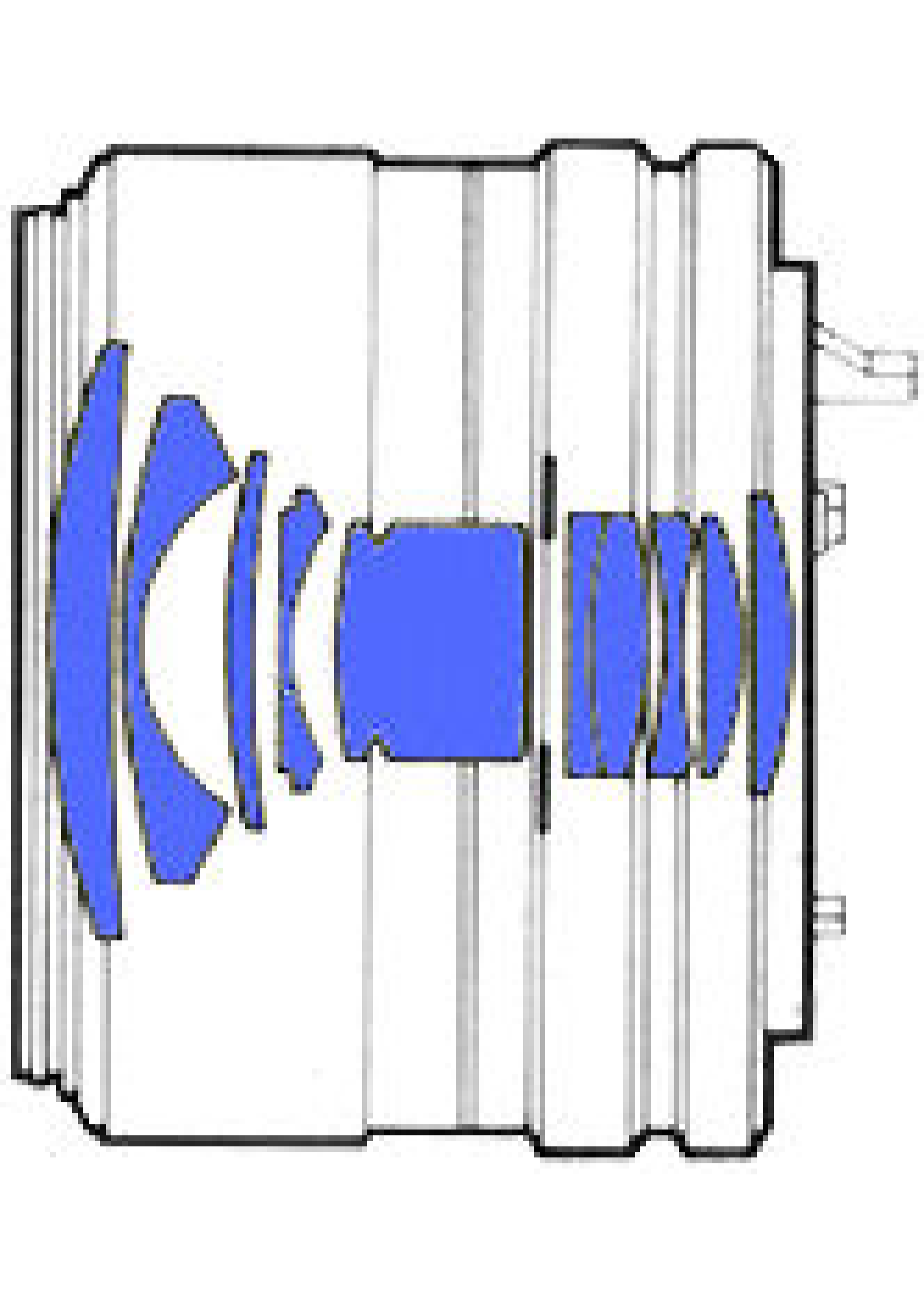












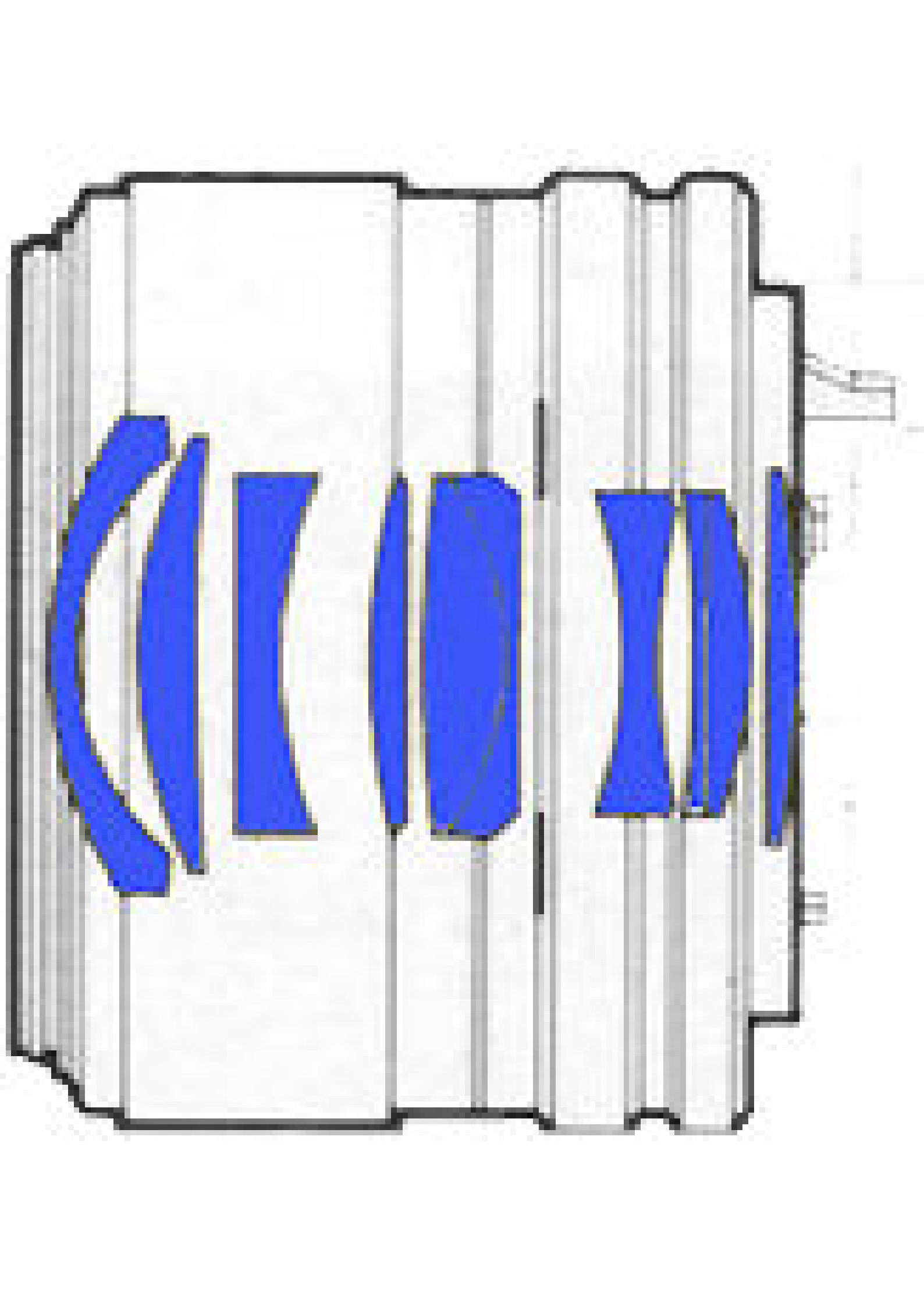
















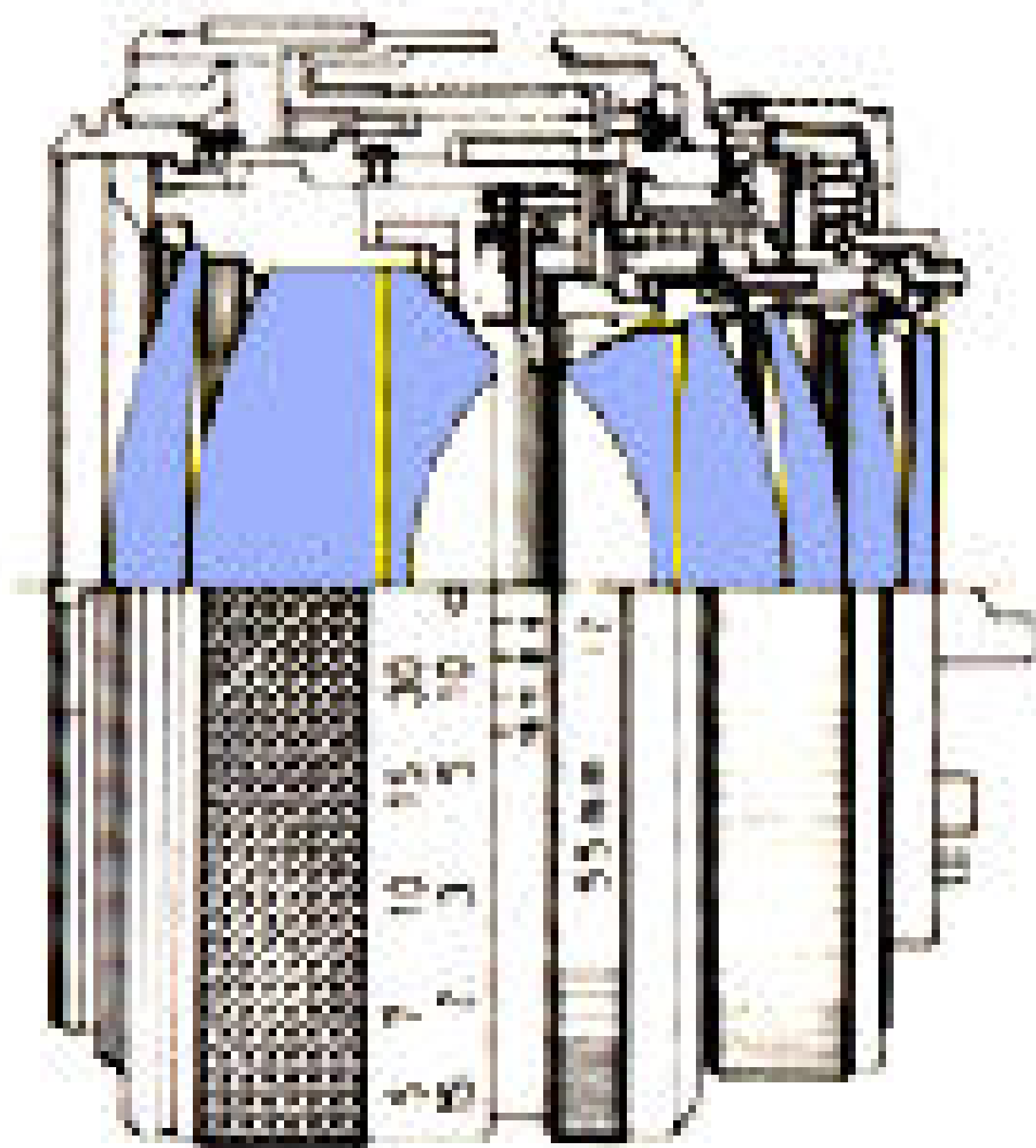










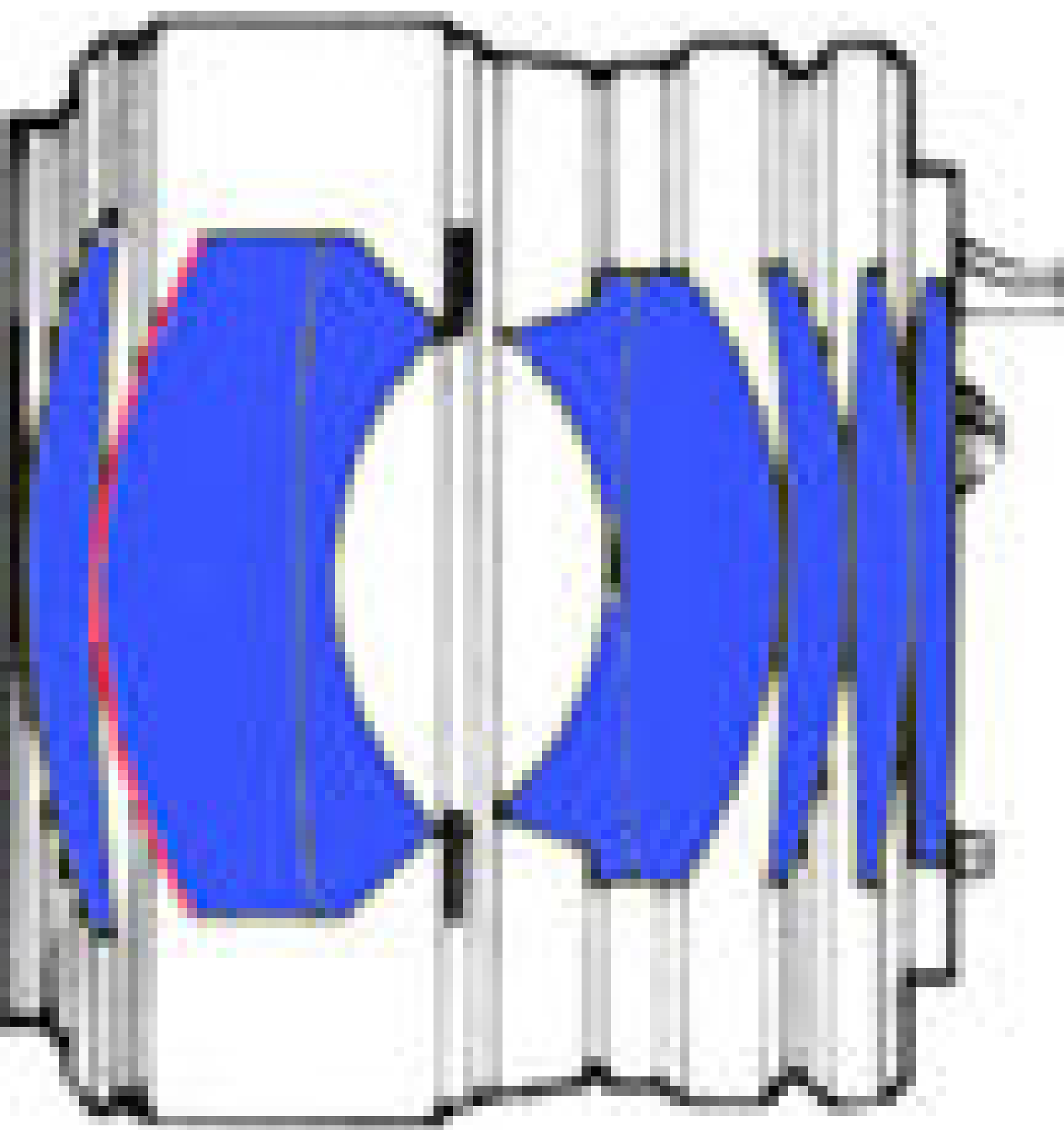














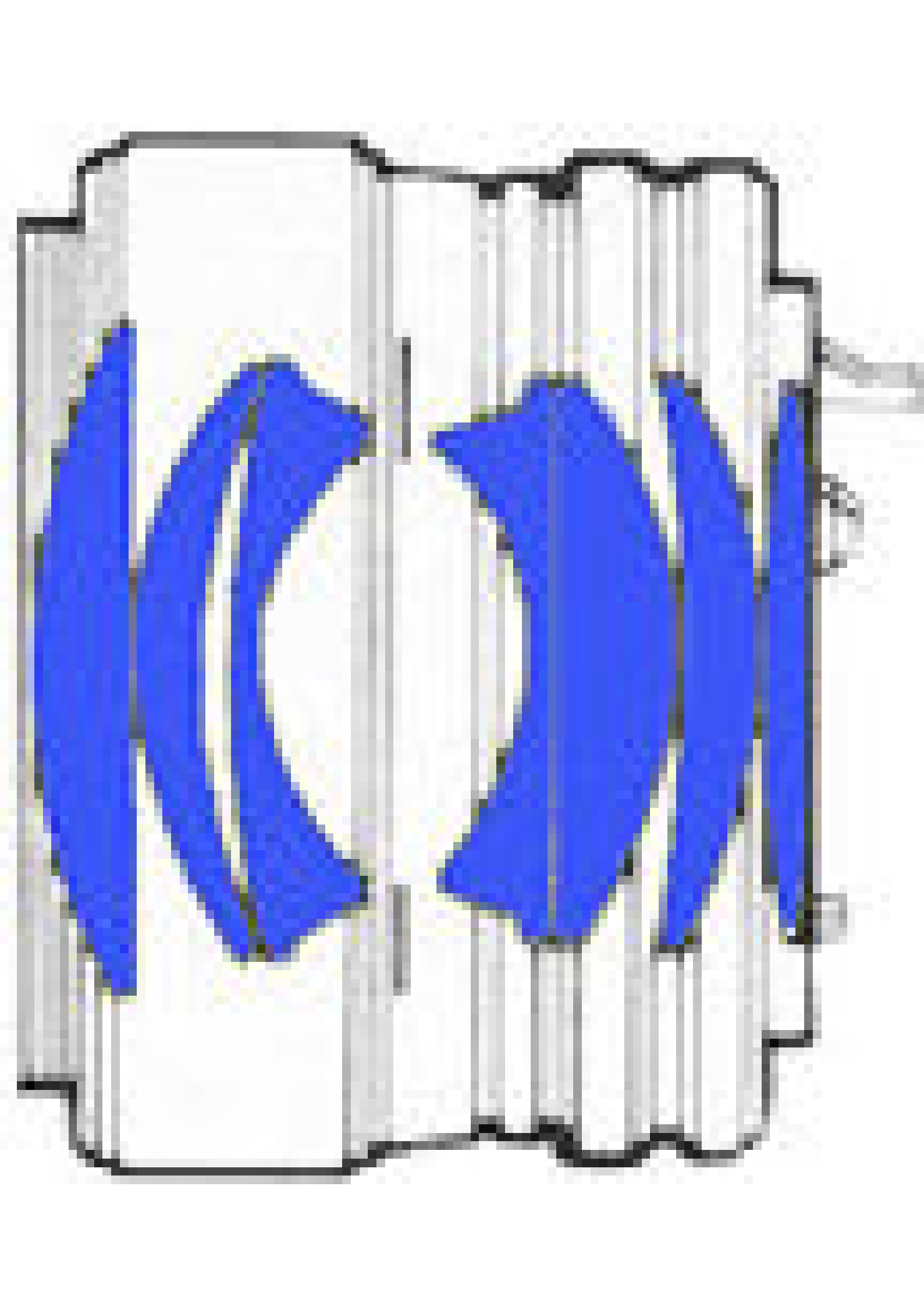










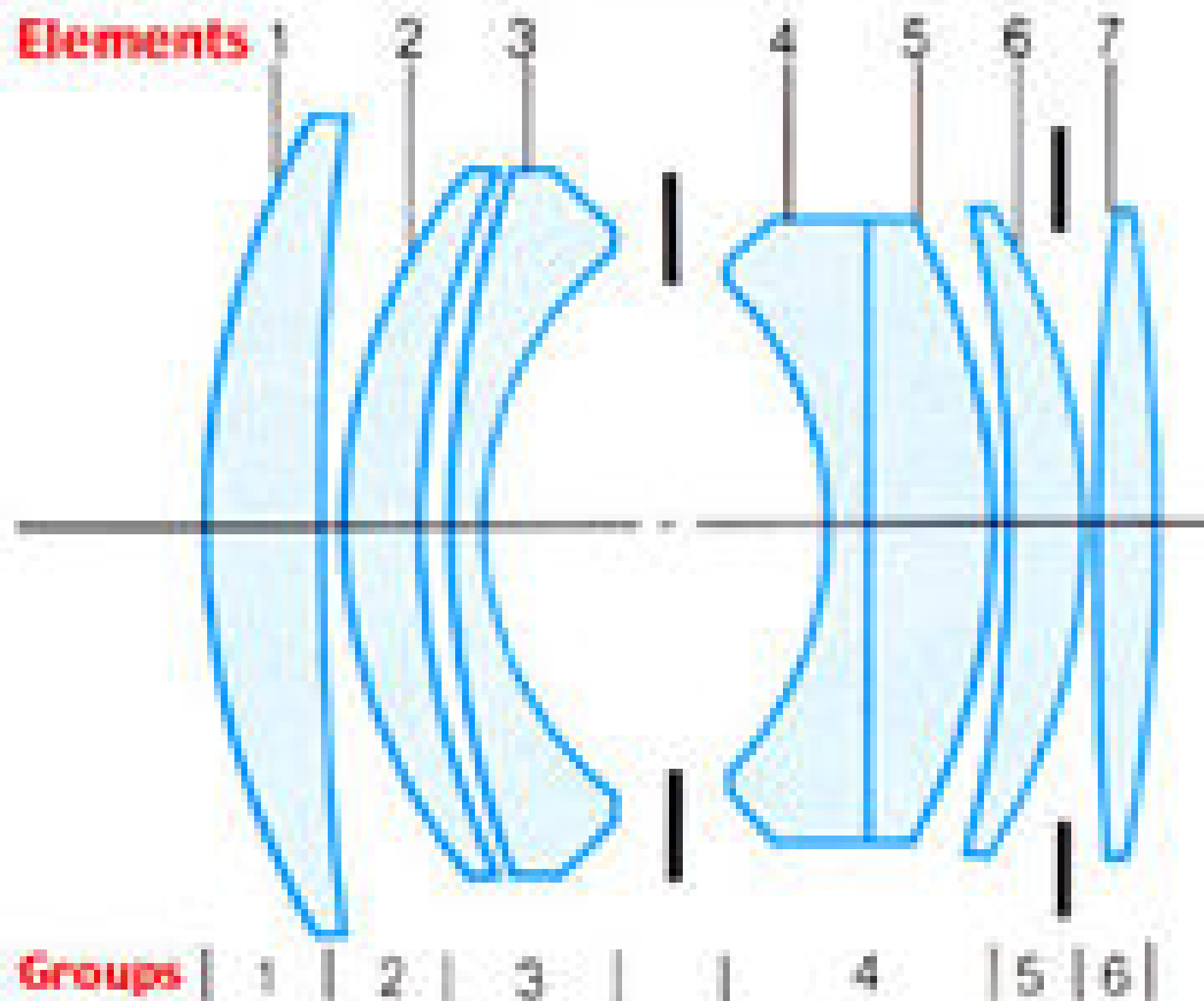






Construction of a Canon's 50mm f1.4 lens (7 elements in 6 groups)

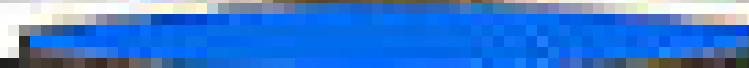

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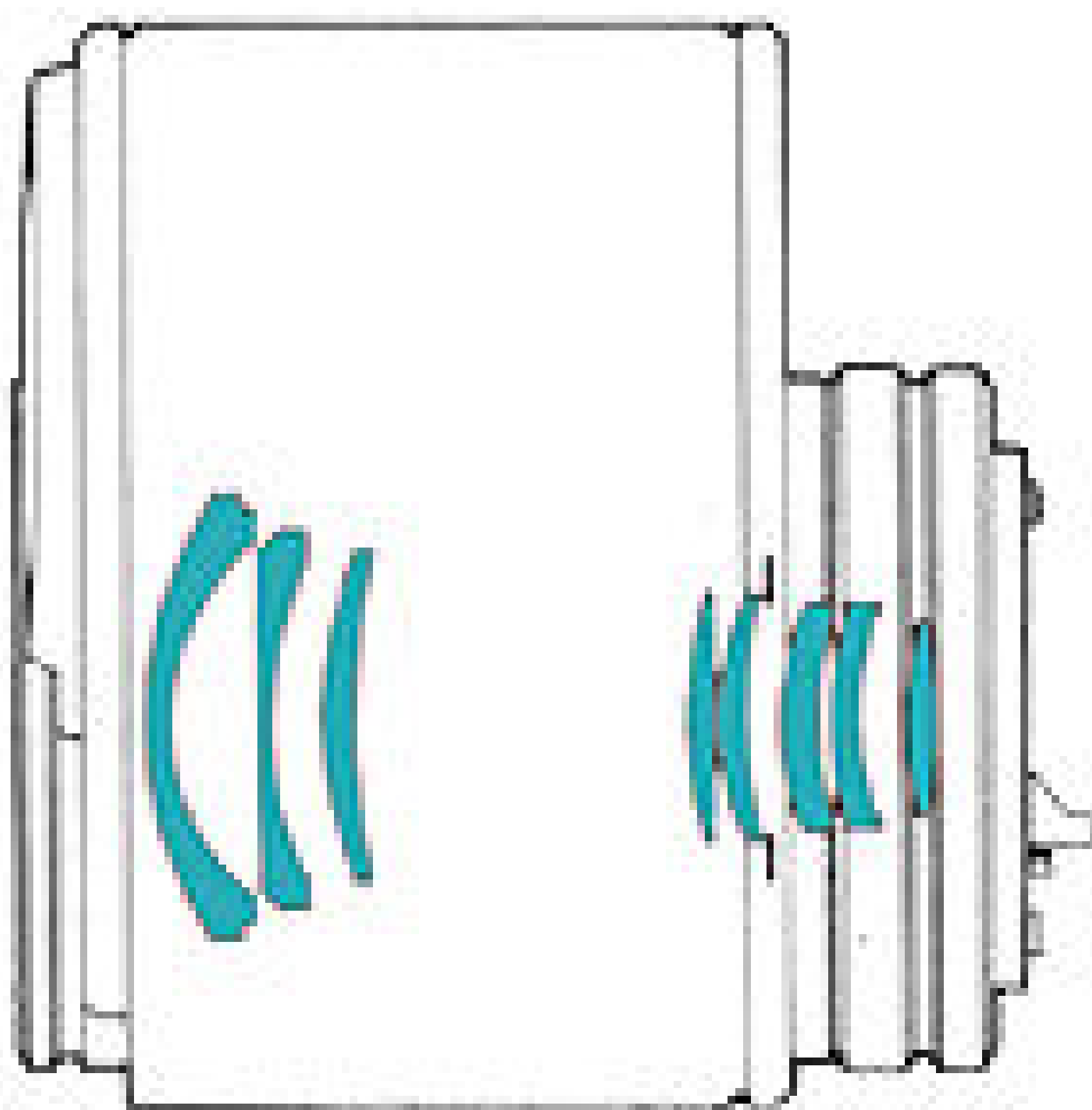
