The lens with the shorter focal length will have more depth while the longer focal length will have less. Your PETRI 1.9 is engraved with a depth of Seld scale which will aid you greatly in bringing your subject into proper focus for quick unop abots.

FLASH SYNCHRO-NIZATION

The M.K.Y. shatter of PETRI 1.9 is provided with synchronization for practically all types of flash

- MEDIUM (NO.5, 25 and Banton 8) type flash bilbs may be used to make flash pictures at all stutter speeds. When using these bilbs, place the SYNCHIO SWITCH on the "M" position. At the shutter speed 1/25 see, or slower. "X" position is also available.
- FAST (SM,SF and SS) type bulbs synchronize perfectly at the shutter speeds from 1 to 1/50 sec.
 When using these bulbs the SYNCHRO SWITCH is
 - placed on the "X" position.

 * ELECTRONIC Flosh Equipment may be used for synchronization at all shutter speeds by placing the SYNCHRO SWITCH on the "X" position. The SULF-TIMER is available by placing the SYNCHRO SWITCH on the "X" position.
