SHUTTER SPEED

The Shutter Speed controls the duration of the exposure. Shutter speeds on this camera with its fine Copal Shutter are 1, 1/2, 1/4, 1/8, 1/15, 1/30, 1/60, 1/125, 1/250, 1/500 of as econd end B. The 'B' setting is for taking pictures with an exposure longer than I second. Use a Tripod or Brace when using 8.
